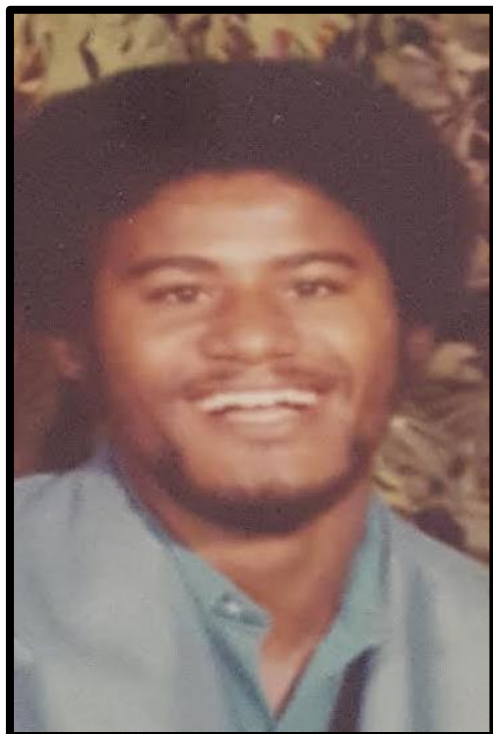

CASH REWARD UP TO \$2,500

On Friday, October 14, 1983 at 9:30 p.m., 22-year-old Michael Greenwell was involved in a minor car accident in the area of Sherman Avenue and Harvard Street in Flint. Instead of stopping, Mr. Greenwell left the scene of the accident and was followed by the other vehicle at a high rate of speed.

Mr. Greenwell drove to Roberts Street and pulled into a driveway in the 900 block. The other vehicle parked at the end of the driveway and the driver exited his vehicle, approached the passenger side of Greenwell's car and shot him as he sat in the driver's seat.

Witnesses described the suspect as a black male, 25-30 years old, approximately 5'6", with a dark complexion and a muscular build.

Witnesses and forensic evidence determined the suspect's vehicle was a two-tone, dark metallic green 1974-1977 Ford, possibly an LTD. Besides the driver there were at least three other individuals in the Ford.
